### Motivation letter

The motivation letter for the scholarship needs to be a different letter than the one you already uploaded as part of your application for the Master's programme. It should explain why you need this scholarship in order to be able to attend Radboud University.

**Please write a motivation letter of maximum 1 page (500 words).**

1. Introduction of who you are, tell us about your (and your family's) socio-economic background
2. Explain why you do not have sufficient funds to study at Radboud University. For example:
  - You do not have personal funds available
  - You do not have parents or guardians who are able to support you financially
  - You do not have access to (other) grants
  - You do not have access to subsidised loans
3. Let us know why you believe that you deserve this scholarship.
