



KDC-database International diversity among Catholics in the Netherlands

The Netherlands hosts many Roman-Catholic communities and organisations with foreign roots. For instance, communities that have (once) been founded by labour migrants, refugees, expats, international students, and communities of eastern-Catholic churches. Additionally, there are organisations to support them; for example, by organising activities for the youth, providing social support, liturgical choirs, supporting priests, raising funds, or organising pilgrimages. With the database on International Diversity, the Catholic Documentation Centre (KDC) wants to show how diverse the Roman-Catholic community in the Netherlands is.

Is your community, group or organisation:

- based in the Netherlands,
 - ...associated with the Roman-Catholic church,
 - ...and founded by or for people from abroad, or around an eastern-Catholic rite,
- then we will be happy to add its details to our database.

If your organisation comprises several independent groups, you may fill out a separate form for each of them.

Feel free to fill out the form as suits you best: on paper, by e-mail, or by telephone (by appointment only).

What happens to your details?

- *A public version of the database, without any contact details*, is available on our website.
- *An extended version of the database, with general contact details*, is available by application only. For instance, for study, research or policy purposes. The applicant signs a declaration in advance that he/she will handle the data with care. The applicant declares not to pass on the data to others, not to publish it himself and not to use it commercially.
- *The working document, with private contact details*, such as a mobile phone number for the secretariat, is only accessible to direct employees of the KDC.
