





Health insurance requirements	Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) is a compulsory requirement for obtaining an Australian student visa. In 2020, the cost for one semester (6 months coverage) was AU\$330 and the cost for two semesters (15 months coverage) was AU\$771. ## **VISA REQUIREMENTS**

Students must hold a current visa which entitles them to study for the duration of their program. Typically this is a subclass 500 student visa. Students should apply for a student visa as soon as they receive their electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE). All visas are subject to conditions and students must ensure they comply with the conditions of their visa at all times.


