The cost of this is usually £100 per exam. If the examination is online, there will be no charge. If a reciprocal arrangement can be put in place for incoming and outgoing students, then there will also not be a charge.</p>

Course load/semester	3 modules per semester (60 UK credit points/30 ECTS). Exchange students on Postgraduate / Masters courses can only study for 1 semester, we cannot accept full year exchange students due to the course duration.
Credit system	10 UK Credit Points = 5 ECTS 20 UK Credit Points = 10 ECTS
