

Integrative


Having a deep understanding of the fundamental areas of business combined with an awareness of how these areas continuously interact with one another and the abilities to use this knowledge.

Course Load and Selection

1 course = 1.5 UVic units = 6 ECTS

A normal course work load for Canadian students is 5 courses (7.5 units or 30 ECTS Credits)

Exchange students can take 3-5 courses depending on their academic comfort level

3 courses (4.5 units of 18 ECTS Credits) is the minimum course load for international students
