Public transportation

Radboud University campus is accessible by bus.

From Nijmegen station to Huize Heyendaal

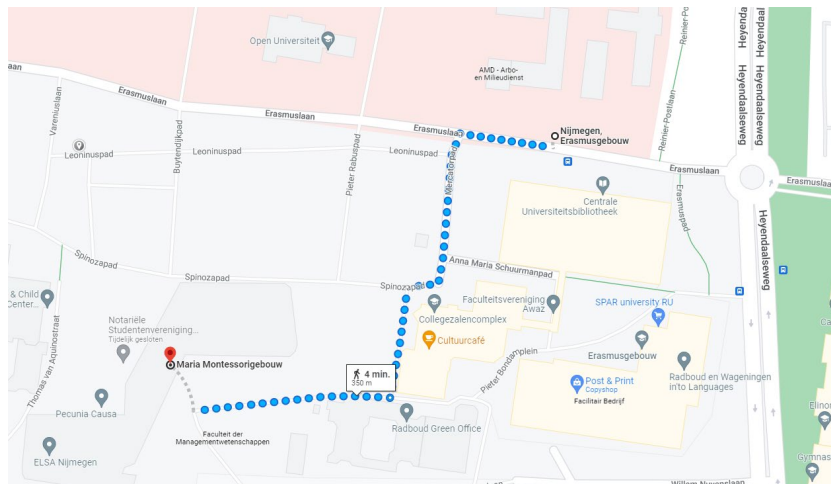
- NIAG Bus line 58 (final stop: Nijmegen HAN)
- Bus line 6 (final stop: Station Dukenburg)
- Bus line 10 (final stop: Heyendaal)
- Bus line 83 (final stop: Venlo Bus Station)
- **All stop at Radboud UMC, Nijmegen (the Radboud Medical Centre).**
The medical centre is located +/- 150 meters from Huize Heyendaal, where the registration and welcome dinner are held, among other activities.



From Nijmegen station to campus buildings (Huygens Building, Erasmus Building or Spinoza Building/Dentistry stop)

- Bus line 10 (final stop: Heyendaal)
- Bus line 300 (final stop: Heyendaal)
- Bus line 12 (final stop: Druten)

If you want to visit the Maria Montessori building, you can best stop at the Erasmus Building bus stop. From here you can walk this route to the Maria Montessori building



From Nijmegen Heyendaal station

- NIAG Bus line 58 (final stop: Nijmegen HAN)
- Bus line 10 (final stop: Heyendaal)
- Bus line 300 (final stop: Heyendaal)
- Bus line 12 (final stop: Druten)

Back to the hotel/B&B

To find your way back, please take the same bus line on the other side of the street.

OV-chip card and recharge point

For traveling by public transport you will need a OV-chip card, which can be purchased at (Schiphol) airport and at the Nijmegen railway station. Adding credit to the card can be done at the same (yellow) ticket machines. Once you travel by train, you have to check in and check out with your OV-chip card before entering the train. If you travel by bus, you can check in and check out in the bus with your card.

At the main entrance of the University Library (Erasmusslaan 36) you will also find a charging point for the OV-Chip card. Up-to-date public transport information can be found on 9292.nl and Google Maps.
