PROFILE

The *Universidad Pontificia Comillas*, also referred as Comillas, is a private Catholic higher education institution that combines a long history of experience in education, academic excellence and a humanistic tradition in teaching, with a commitment to continuous modernisation, stimulated by new social and cultural challenges. Online Application: Nominated students will receive an email with instructions on how to apply, as well as their username and password.</p> <p>Phase I - Admission: Fill out the online application and upload a passport-size photo and a copy of your valid passport or ID.</p> <p>Deadlines for Phase I: First/Fall semester: 30th June. Second/Spring semester: 10th December.</p> <p>STEP 3. Acceptance: Once Phase I has been completed Comillas University will confirm the admission to the student by e-mail and will send additional information about Orientation Days, Spanish courses, etc. Non-EU students will receive an acceptance letter from Comillas in order to apply for a visa. Entry requirements - Spain</p>
<p>Language of Instruction and Requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spanish level B1 (B2 recommended) for courses taught in Spanish. • English level B1 (B2 recommended) for courses taught in English. <p>We do not need to see the test results but ask all our partners to make sure their students have this level before nominating them to us.</p> <p>Academic Workload Max. 35 credits (ECTS) per semester. 1 ECTS credit is equivalent to 25 working hours. Exchange students usually take 20-25 ECTS per semester.</p>	<p>Course Catalogue</p> <p>The Faculty of Law offers courses in the fields of Law, Business and International Relations. List of Courses 2021-2022</p> <p>Students are not allowed to mix courses from another Faculty. Business students have priority in choosing Business courses. The final acceptance for a particular course is subject to availability. Postgraduate courses are restricted to partners with specific agreements.</p> <p>Important: While every effort is made to enrol exchange students on the courses requested on their applications, it cannot be guaranteed. Exchange students are urged to be flexible. English courses may fill up quickly.</p>
<p>Courses Pre-Registration and Official Enrolment</p>	
<p>Phase II – Courses Pre-Registration (before the mobility): Students will receive an e-mail in July (for the fall semester) and December (for the spring semester) with the dates to pre-register for their courses.</p> <p>Phase III-Enrolment (upon arrival): Proof of health insurance must be uploaded to the online application and the data must be completed before submitting the registration. Please bear in mind that no student will be allowed to enrol without showing proof of health insurance.</p> <p>Application deadlines for Phases II and III:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First/Fall semester: 16th September. • Second/Spring semester: 31st January. 	

Spanish Language Course (free)		Transcript of Records	
<p>'Español para alumnos de intercambio' (Spanish for exchange students), 6 ECTS distributed throughout the term. This course is free and optional.</p> <p>Levels: A1, A2, B1, B2 and C1. The course "Lengua Española a través de la Historia y el Arte" (only for students with a C1 level of Spanish) is offered only in the second semester.</p> <p><u>Level test:</u> students must take a level test. Students will receive an email in July or December with instructions on how to take the test online. Those that do not take the test on time are not guaranteed a place.</p> <p>If the student needs credits for this course, they must include this in the enrolment sheet.</p>		<p>Transcripts shall be sent directly to the coordinator of the home University by email at the end of February for Fall semester students and at the end of July for annual and Spring semester students.</p> <p>The documents that are electronically signed by the General Registry of the <i>Universidad Pontificia Comillas</i> include a secure verification code (CSV as per the Spanish) that allows them to be downloaded online.</p> <p>The secure verification code allows the citizen to present a printed copy of the electronic document to another institution that will be able to check its authenticity and that it has not been altered.
