



## Scholarships at the Institute of Eastern Christian Studies: Building academic networks

The Institute views awarding scholarships to international PhD students as a mutually beneficial opportunity for scholars and our institute to expand its academic network and thus enhance the quality of research and consultancy activities. Every year, there are two scholarships available: one in the field of Orthodox Christianity and one in the field of Oriental Christianity. The visiting scholar/PhD student is expected to work in the Institute or its library at Radboud University in Nijmegen and contribute to the scholarly work of the research program of the institute by lecturing and/or publishing.

Twice a year (15 March and 1 September), applications for the next semester are considered. Per scholarship, the amount of €1500,- per person is available. A working space and electronic access to the library in the Institute will be made available.

To be considered, please submit the following:

- A a brief research proposal (max. 1000 words) that makes clear what the researcher hopes to achieve during the IECS period, and how that fits into his/her larger research plan, including some suggestions as how the researcher aims to contribute to the aims of the Institute (journal, article for the Platform Oosters Christendom, lecture, other), and a tentative time schedule.
- Your CV, including a list of publications
- A reference letter, from the primary supervisor in case of a PhD student, or from the head of the department/institute/college in case of a senior scholar.

Conditions:

- Only applicants who **reside outside of the Netherlands** are eligible for the scholarship.
