TUITION, HOUSING, AND LIVING EXPENSES

Approximate costs for the Exchange program at CSUB:

- ☐ Tuition Your home university tuition (paid to home university)
- ☐ Housing and meals \$4,000–\$6,700 per semester
- ☐ Health insurance \$580 (required for all students) per semester
- ☐ Recreation center fee Waived upon request
