



## Overview of traffic classes

A traffic class indicates which coverage you have in your package. This means numbers that you can call.

Each higher class includes the previous coverage with additional options.

| <b>Class</b>      | <b>Coverage</b>                          |
|-------------------|--|
| Class 1           | Internal and alarm number 5555 and 0-112 |
| Class 2           | Class 1 + national + free numbers        |
| Class 3 (default) | Class 2 + Mobile                         |
| Class 4           | Class 3 + paid service numbers           |
| Class 5           | Class 4 + Europe                         |
| Class 6           | Class 5 + World                          |
| Class 7           | Class 6 + payment services               |
| Class 8           | Miscellaneous                            |
| Class 9           | Free                                     |

It is possible to set the day and night mode for a traffic class of a landline telephone differently. Day mode runs from 7.00 am to 8.00 pm. Night mode runs from 8.00 pm to 7.00 am.
