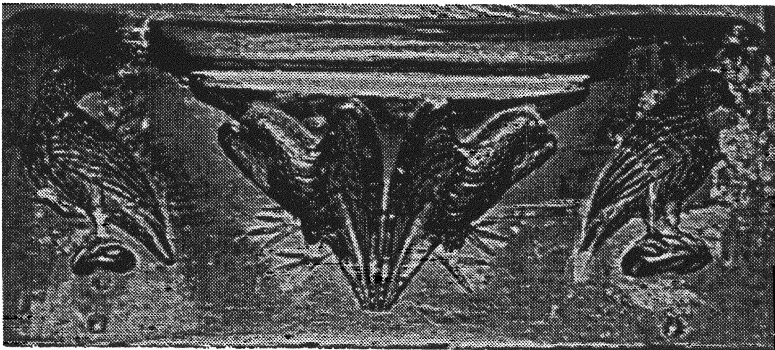
Gaillon (Eure): **Château de Gaillon** now partially restored and open to the public, summers only.
