Dates and Deadlines

OSU's academic year has four quarters, or terms, rather than semesters. You can attend OSU for 1-3 terms, in either Fall, Winter or Spring, depending on the agreement we have with your university.

The application deadline varies, depending on which term you are applying to start the exchange program:

Fall Term 2025

24 September -	Apply by April 1, 2025
12 December 2025	April 1, 2025

Winter Term 2026

	Apply by
20 March 2026	October 1, 2025

Spring Term 2026

30 March –	Apply by
12 June 2026	January 1, 2026

Exchange students do **not** normally attend OSU in summer term but check with your home school coordinator to see if that is an option.

All exchange students must plan to arrive about **one week before** the first day of the term, as we will welcome all exchange students at the mandatory Orientation meeting before classes begin.

You should expect to stay on campus until the last day of term, as you may have a final exam on that day.

Information for incoming international exchange students

Student Fees

No tuition fees are charged to students coming to OSU in the College of Business exchange program.

General mandatory student fees that are charged to all students per term is **US\$830**. These fees cover access to recreational facilities, student club participation, use of the Corvallis transit system, and other on-campus student services that you will use while on exchange.

Health Insurance

All exchange students are required to have full health insurance whilst attending OSU. Health insurance term of attendance are included in costs for each the program fees.*

*Providing evidence of having the same level of health insurance coverage from your home country may enables students to submit a request to waive health insurance fees.

Advanced English language skills are required for OSU Business courses. Your home university will confirm your English proficiency as part of your application (TOEFL waiver form). We do not offer preparatory English Language courses before the start of the term.

Living on campus

OSU student housing options vary, depending upon residence hall and room occupancy availability. Prices range from US\$3226-\$5507 per term. A dining plan will cost about US \$1000-\$1800 per term.*

*If you cancel your exchange after signing a housing contract with OSU, you may be required to pay cancellation fees depending on when you cancel the contract.
