| Estimated cost of housing | Between \$2660 and \$3690 per semester |
| Where do exchange students eat? | There are several cafeterias and places to buy food on campus. Students can get a meal plan. |
| Estimated cost of food | Meal plans range from \$1588 to \$2052 per semester and include a number of set meals as well as money to buy food a la carte. |
