ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible, students must meet the following entry requirements:

- Completion of one full year of study at university level with satisfactory grades (U.S. 2.5 GPA or higher).
- **English language proficiency** equivalent to IELTS 6.0 for undergraduate or 6.5 for postgraduate applicants.

EXCHANGE NOMINATIONS

Partner institutions, please complete the **ACU Inbound Nomination Form** for each student you wish to nominate.

Upon receiving your nomination(s), ACU will be in contact to confirm.

Application guidelines will be sent directly to the nominated students, and ACU will copy in the contact at the partner university.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

To apply, students must submit the following documents:

- Copy of official academic transcript
- Copy of personal information page of passport
- English proficiency results (if applicable)
- Personal statement

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Students are required to submit applications by the deadlines below and allow time to obtain a student visa.

Semester 1 (February to June):
apply by 15 November

Semester 2 (July to November):
apply by 15 May



APPLICATION PROCESS

If you are looking to start your Australian study adventure, we're here to help. We've broken down the application process into four easy steps.

1. Request nomination from your home university.*
2. Check you meet academic entry and English language requirements.
3. Choose campus and units to study.
4. Apply to ACU.

ACU COURSE HANDBOOK

Students have the flexibility to choose courses from various study areas across our four faculties. However, it's important to keep in mind that not all units are available on every campus. Additionally, students must meet the prerequisite requirements for the courses they wish to study.

Unit requests: Students must request, in their application, at least 6 ACU units to study at their preferred campus; to allow for availability and time table changes.

Refer to the **ACU Handbook** for unit outlines (syllabi).

Study level: Undergraduate and postgraduate.

Language of instruction: English.

Restricted courses: Midwifery, Occupational Therapy and Paramedicine.

Study load: A standard full-time study load is 3 to 4 units (30 to 40 credit points) per semester. Students must comply with student visa requirements:

- Enrol in a minimum of 30CP
- Only enrol in 10CP of online study.

Typically, 10CP at ACU is equivalent to:

- 3 to 4 U.S. credit hours
- 7.5 ECTS.

STUDENT VISA REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to hold a valid Australian visa for the duration of their study in Australia and can apply as soon as a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) is issued from ACU. Most study abroad and exchange students will apply for a Student

Visa (subclass 500) Non-Award Sector; however before applying for any visa, it is important to fully understand the type and the conditions of each visa.

Living in ACU student accommodation is a great way to get the most of your university experience. Students will experience community living in an inclusive and supportive environment with students from Australia and the world.

ENGLISH + STUDY ABROAD

Develop your English to meet the entry requirements for the study abroad program or simply improve your English before beginning your academic semester. Study at ACU Melbourne or Sydney English Language Centre for 5 to 20 weeks. Choose from General English, IELTS preparation or English for Academic Purposes, followed by a study abroad semester.
