Study options

International Exchange Programme is designed for students from our partner universities. You will still pay regular fees to your home university.

Study Abroad Programme is ideal for students currently studying at an accredited institution outside China. You will be required to pay a flat fee to UNNC to cover the cost of tuition.

Scholarship

Scholarships are available to students who are seeking a semester or an academic year's study at University of Nottingham Ningbo China. Please consult Global Engagement Office for more information.

Entry requirements

Students applying for the International Exchange Programme must be nominated by their home university. Students applying for the Study Abroad Programme must hold good average results in university studies to

Applicants from non-English speaking countries must submit evidence of English language proficiency at the time of application. You should have an IELTS score of 6.5 (6 in each of the 4 components) or equivalent. A Language sufficient letter issued from home university would also be acceptable.

Autumn semester: Mid September - end January Spring semester: Mid February - mid June Academic year: Mid September - mid June

Application

Applications should be completed using our online form. Some documentation will also need to be uploaded at the same time as the application-namely: your most recent transcript, passport identity page, passport size photo. Non-native English speakers must also provide their latest English score.

Deadlines

Autumn semester (September start): 1 May Spring semester (February start): 30 October

Student visas

International students applying to study in China will require a student visa.

There are two types of student visa:

- 1. The X1 VISA is issued to those who intend to study in China for more than 180 days.
- 2. The X2 VISA is issued to those who intend to study in China for less than 180 days.


