

How students will be matriculated:

- ✓ Exchanges student at undergraduate
- ✓ 4 internship topics
- ✓ Student can take also 2 extra courses in our Campus if interested

Work hours and credits:

- ✓ Each internship course is equivalent 160 work hours
- ✓ Full time internship: 8 hours 5 times a week
- ✓ Each course: 3 USA credits – 8 Mexican units – 5 ECTS

Grades:

- ✓ Inside Tec students will have a tutor
- ✓ Final grade: essays, boss evaluation, and final presentation
- ✓ Official transcript is issued at the end

- Tuition fee is waived for partner universities, however, there is a program fee to arrange: opening and closing event, academic and cultural trips, orientation Session, student ID card, welcome kit, access to all Campus facilities and extracurricular activities (gym, computer labs, library, sports center, etc.), Buddy Program & Insurance.
- Cost: USD\$1000 (for non-partner universities), USD\$595 (for partner university)*

Before the Student Arrives

Estimated Costs



Host Family Program:

400 USD / 355 EUR per month
(includes three daily meals)

From 180 to 450 USD / 160 to 400 EUR per month
(meals not included)



Meals:

Approx. 200 USD / 178 EUR per month.



Transportation:

Metro or Bus = 0.35 USD / 0.30 EUR
Taxi: 25 minutes = 4 USD / 3.5 EUR
