<b>Application</b>	Students are first nominated by their home university using a web form. After official nomination the EA office will activate the online application and the students will be notified of login details by email. Students do not need to mail in application documents.

<b>Admission Requirements</b>	Students should have the requisite GPA as defined in the MOU. In addition students whose first language isn't English or who aren't studying at a university where English is the language of instructions should be proficient enough with spoken and written English to feel comfortable in academic and social settings; the majority of classes are taught in English. A normal TOEFL range is 78 and 6.0 IELTS. Students who have not taken the TOEFL or IELTS can undergo a language evaluation by their home university and submit this as proof of language ability. If you have students who scored below a 78 or 6.0 please contact our office in advance of nomination.
<b>Accommodation</b>	All exchange students are placed in on-campus housing. The housing application is released to students after their acceptance.
