#### Housing

Exchange students are **required** to live on campus. UIS Residence Life offers many housing options. Housing cost depends on students' selection. We recommend the townhouses option. Please visit <u>Residence Life website</u> to apply for housing and for more information. *You need to secure housing prior to your arrival*.

#### Meal Plan

A few options are available. Students can choose any of the meal plans available: Signature Plan, Gold Plan, Silver Plan, or Bronze Plan. Cost and more information are available on the <u>Dining website</u>. A meal plan is not required for students who select to live in the apartments/townhouses on campus.

#### Approximate Cost

Students coming from partner universities will have their tuition and fees waived. The approximate cost of living per semester is estimated at \$6,500. This includes costs for housing, the meal plan, books, and necessities. Actual costs will vary depending on students' choices.

#### Other Requirements

**Health Insurance:** All students are required to have health insurance at UIS. In addition, exchange students must acquire health insurance for the duration of their exchange program. (International Exchange Students – refer to the guidelines stated on the second page of your DS2019 form).

Students who do not submit a qualifying health insurance policy will be automatically enrolled in the <u>UIS Student Health</u> <u>Insurance</u>.

*Immunization Records:* International students are required to submit Yellow Cards from the World Health Organization (WHO) as evidence for immunizations administered outside of the United States. Please visit the <u>UIS Health</u> Services website for more information.
