PROGNOSIS RESEARCH IN HEALTHCARE

Concepts, methods, and impact

This 3-day online summer school is designed to introduce the key components and uses of prognosis research to health professionals and researchers, including a framework of four different prognosis research questions: overall prognosis, prognostic factors, prognostic models, and stratified care.

The course will cover key principles of study design and methods, interpretation of statistical results about prognosis, the use of prognosis research evidence at multiple stages on the translational pathway toward improving patient outcome, the limitations of current prognosis research, and how the field can be improved. The course consists of lectures from a core faculty of epidemiologists, statisticians and clinical researchers, alongside group work and discussion sessions.
