The projects are designed in a multidisciplinary way and focused on the communication of science in materials such as infographics, infographics, podcast, among others.

NOMINATION PROCESS



Open to bachelor's degree students (this call is not intended for master's or doctoral students).

The international office must send the official nomination to internacional@ugto.mx with the following PDF documents before March 10, 2023:

1. Letter of nomination from the international office with full name and e-mail address, indicating that the student belongs to the top 15% of his/her generation or has an academic average of 9.0 out of 10 where the passing score is 7.0.
2. Self-presentation essay and motivation letter with signature and date indicating the area of studies of interest to do their research during the UG Science Summer 2023.
3. Academic transcript accompanied by a letter from the international office indicating that the student has 50% progress and less than 80% of the total credits to obtain the degree at their home university.
4. Copy of valid passport (photo sheet).
5. Proof of Spanish language proficiency A 1/A2 (non-Spanish speakers). Degree in Teaching Spanish as a Second Language: C1. Spanish speakers: Proof of English language proficiency level B1. (460 TOEFL ITP points).

Students are required to submit a copy of the international medical insurance policy with the following coverage:

Minimum hospitalization coverage of \$100,000 USD (unlimited coverage is recommended), legal advice (civil liability), emergency evacuation and transfer, repatriation of remains, displacement of a family member, coverage for COVID-19 disease and the expenses of the medical consequences of the disease.

Before traveling, the student should consult a general practitioner to take the vaccinations required to travel to Mexico, including the vaccine to prevent COVID-19 disease.

Nominations directly sent by students, incomplete or late will not be accepted.

ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION

Those students whose official nomination to the Summer Research Program 2023 is accepted, will receive an email with username and password to register on the electronic platform of the Office of International Relations and Academic Collaboration (DRICA). The students must complete their registration one calendar week after receiving access.

ASSIGNMENT TO A RESEARCH GROUP



As of May 3rd of 2023, students who have completed their DRICA electronic registration will be part of the research group of a professor from the University of Guanajuato, assigned according to their preferred area of study mentioned in the self-presentation essay and motivation letter. This information will be received by each student by e-mail.

REGISTRATION IN THE RESEARCH GROUP

Students in a research group must register on the Office of Research and Postgraduate Support (DAIP) platform.

LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE

Students are required to submit a copy of their international medical insurance policy with the requested coverage and vaccination card in their electronic DRICA profile, to receive their acceptance letter to the Summer Research Program.
