## NOMINATION AND APPLICATION PROCESS

Nomination deadlines	Fall semester dates (second half of year) – <b>April, 15</b> Spring semester dates (first half of year) – <b>September, 30</b>
Nomination process	<p>Official nominations should be made through our Online Nomination form by the coordinator of a partner university. Each nomination should be submitted separately.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b></p> <p>a) The nominated student’s passport must be valid for at least 18 months from the proposed start date of the visa:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Fall semester 2020 – February 27, 2022</b> (1-3 days’ difference is allowed); <b>Spring semester 2021 – July 15, 2022</b> (1-3 days’ difference is allowed).</p> <p>Otherwise, the student will be required to apply for a new passport.</p> <p>b) Students who are citizens of migration-risk countries are required to have a notarized translation of their passport for visa application.<sup>1</sup></p>
Application deadlines	Fall semester dates (second half of year) – <b>May, 15</b> Spring semester dates (first half of year) – <b>October, 15</b>
Application process	<p>After nomination deadline students will receive a welcome letter from <a href="mailto:international.study@hse.ru">international.study@hse.ru</a> with an invitation to fill out an online student account and attach scans of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Passport: must be valid for at least 18 months from the start date of the planned visa;</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Fall semester 2020 – February 27, 2022</b> (1-3 days’ difference is allowed); <b>Spring semester 2021 – July 15, 2022</b> (1-3 days’ difference is allowed).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ University/college transcripts/records of current studies (if available) (in .pdf/ Original + certified translation in English);</li> <li>✓ Motivation letter (300-500 words/in English);</li> <li>✓ Photo (3x4 cm, passport format).</li> </ul> <p><b><i>After all documents are submitted, students will receive HSE University Letter of Acceptance and Invitation Letter issued by the Migration Authority (if applicable).</i></b></p>
Visa (if necessary)	<p>HSE University provides visa support for international students. Formal visa invitations are ordered through the Russian Ministry of Internal Affairs for every student. The visa invitation is required to obtain a student visa. The first visa issued is a three-month single-entry visa. It is then extended to a multiple-entry visa, which shall be valid for the entire period of the student’s exchange.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> Students should be ready to stay in Russia without leaving for a 90-day period after the initial arrival until the multiple-entry visa is received.</p>

Students are expected to register at least 60 % of the courses at one HSE faculty/institute based on their home university major, being able to take up to 40 % of their credits from a different study area (depending on availability and overlaps).
Course / department restrictions (if any)	Acceptance to certain courses may be subject to the given department's approval.
Language of teaching	Russian and English
Recommended language level	For courses taught in English – no less than an English level of B2 (TOEFL iBT 75/IELTS 6.5)  For courses taught in Russian – no less than a Russian level C1 (based on the <a href="#">Common European Framework of Reference for Languages</a> levels)
Credit system (ECTS or any other)	HSE University relies on the ECTS system 1 ECTS = 38 academic hours = 24 astronomical hours 1 academic hour = 40 minutes / 1 astronomical hour = 60 minutes
Usual workload	30 ECTS per semester, 60 ECTS per year
