## COURSES

Students can choose courses taught in **French and/or** in **English**.

- We offer 25 english-taught classes each semester.
- **Five english-taught courses** are exclusively designed **each semester** only for **Erasmus students**, guaranteeing a **conflict-free schedule**.
- Undergraduate students can choose both, undergraduate and graduate courses.
- Some courses are submitted to prior assessment of the student's background.
- Students are granted a two-week period after the orientation meeting to change their courses if needed.

## FRENCH LANGUAGE COURSE

Students can enroll for **FREE** to the French Language courses [30 hours / semester] and may earn **4 ECTS**.

## LIVING EXPENSES

**University's residences:** from 475€ / per month

**Room or flat in the city:** per month = from 300€ (room in the owner's house), from 370€ month (shared apartment), from 550€ (a studio)

**Lodging with a host family:** from 500€ / month

**Private student residence:** from 490€ / month

Other expenses

**City transport:** 25€ for a monthly subscription for the under 25s

**Food:** about 200€ / month. Lunch at the university cafeteria is around **4€**
