

Welcome to the Library of Science



Team Library of Science gives new science students a warm welcome! We have 10 important tips to make a great start.

1. Study environment

The Library of Science is a great place to study! You can walk in and pick a spot, except in Wing 2: there you reserve a study spot or group work place via face.ru.nl. Log in with your S-number and corresponding password. You can book 2 days in advance. You can choose between a place with or without PC.

2. PC's, laptops, wifi

All PCs in our library run on Windows (except 8, which run on Linux). If all PC spots are reserved, you can borrow a **laptop for a day** from the service desk. Be sure to have your ID with you. You can connect your own laptop or phone to [Eduroam](https://eduroam.org). To charge your phone or laptop, you can borrow a **power bank** or mobile outlet from the service desk. Moving away from your place temporarily? Borrow a laptop lock or store your laptop or phone in a **locker**. Those also contain power outlets! Be sure to empty and leave your locker clean before closing time.

3. Opening hours

Monday - Friday: 8.15 am – 9.30 pm

Saturday & Sunday: 10.00 am – 6.00 pm


During Summer and Christmas holidays our opening hours are adjusted. Keep an eye on the screens in the faculty.

4. Finding literature

Start your search for **scientific literature** at the [Library Guide Science](#). Through this guide you have **access** to all the search engines and subscriptions of the library, even from home!

5. Borrowing

With your student card you can borrow books **free of charge** at the Library of Science and all other libraries on campus. You first need to activate your account in RUQuest (manual in the [Library Guide Science](#)), the database which contains all the books & journals we have at the RU. You can request a book via [RUQuest](#) and pick it up at the Library of Science and use our lending machine. Returning books is possible at every library location of the Radboud University.

 Tip: we have a lot of **study literature available as e-book!** A link to the [Study Guide E-literature](#) is also in our [Library Guide Science](#).

6. Printing

Printing is possible via **Kuario**. To get this installed, check the manual in our [Library Guide Science](#). During the first two weeks of September, you can visit the nearby service desk Monday through Friday from 10:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. for help and information about Kuario and app installation. Fellow students will show you around.

7. Service desk & facilities

Our hostesses Judith and Charlotte are happy to help you with questions. During evening hours and the weekends student are at the Servicedesk to help you. Near the service desk, we have **staplers**, a **binding machine** and a machine for **laminating**. We sell sheets for that.

8. Vending machine

Buy all sorts of supplies at the vending machine across our service desk! USB-sticks, college blocks, pencils etc. etc.

9. (Social) Media

Keep an eye on the **screens** in the faculty and follow our students' [Facebook](#) page. Also regularly check our news items on our [website](#). You will also find them in the faculty newsletter you receive monthly.
